

BEER

Although we have a passion for wine, there is a world of beer making that is taken very seriously and serves to be delicious as well. Similar to our wines, we researched and tasted beers that have minimal reputation but are respectably produced. This menu of micro handcrafted beers has been created for you to experience those that we loved and feel deserves the proper praise.

Belgium

Piraat 11.2 oz./\$9 750 ml./\$27

A hoppy, unique combination that blends perfectly! A "living beer" that is re-fermented in the bottle, this beer is spicy with sweet citrus undertones, as well as an assertive earthiness due to the huge malt profile. **10.5% abv**

Gulden Draak 11.2 oz./\$10.50 750 ml./\$29

"Golden Dragon", beware the power of this beer! It is a dark Triple, utilizing darker malts and dark candy sugars to produce a toffee and caramel taste upfront with a pleasant hop finish. A light smokiness adds to this beer's mystery! Great with chocolates!! **10.5% abv.**

Troubadour Obscura 11.2 oz/\$

A "Mild Stout", it has a ruby color not as dark as English and Irish stouts. It has a great dark, ripened fruit taste from the yeast and caramel and toffee sweetness from the malts. **8% abv.**

Bavik Pilsner 11.2 oz/\$5.50

A Pilsner with a distinctive creamy aspect from the yeast. A beautiful nose of mellow grassiness and hay, and a nice hop note in the backend from the hops. Light in color and alcohol. **5% abv.**

Steenbrugge Blonde 750 ml/\$20

A Blonde Ale that has a beautiful malt profile, a touch of sweetness from the candi sugars, a pleasant floral note from the yeast and the addition of Gruut, which is a combination of herbs and spices that Belgian brewers used before hops were put into beer. **6.5% abv.**

Poperings Hommel Ale 11.2 oz/\$8.50

A hoppy Blonde from the #1 hop growing region of Belgium. A great mix of earthy flavors from the malt and the hops, with notes of Rose and Hibiscus as well as good fruit and mineral notes throughout. This beer uses only Belgian hops grown in the Poperinge area of Belgium. A rare treat! **7% abv.**

La Divine Triple 11.2 oz/\$10.50

An all malt Triple which relies on the sugars from the malts to sweeten the beer unlike most Triples that use candi sugars. An amber colored beer that pairs up well with pork and chicken dishes as well as heartier sauces. **9% abv.**

Augustijn Abbey Ale 11.2 oz./\$8.50 750 ml./\$24

A Full-bodied Triple with an amber color and a spicy, malty palate that finishes very fruity with complex hoppy undertones. Great with spicier, heartier dishes. **8% abv.**

Petrus "Gouden" Triple 11.2 oz/\$9.00

A very light, effervescent "Golden" Triple which uses different yeast strains and candi sugars to give off sweet floral and citrus notes and a nice hop note. A pale colored beer that pairs up well with cheeses and lighter fare. **7.5% abv.**

Rodenbach Red 11.2 oz/\$6.50

A Red Ale that uses complex yeast strains, a rich malt character and a centuries' old tradition of oak barrel aging to produce one of the most unique styles in the world! This beer is refreshing on the palate, with a lot of malt sweetness, a tart acidic note from the "Wild Yeast", and a noticeable nuttiness from the wood notes of the oak barrels. Big notes of sour cherry and tart citrus, as well as caramel and toffee sweetness. **5% abv.**

Leffe Blonde Ale 11.2oz/\$6.00

A dry, fruity and lightly spiced Belgian Abbey Ale, Leffe Blonde features a perfect balance of strength and subtlety. The bitterness is delicate, extending over the whole palate and lingering as a subtle aftertaste. **6% abv.**

Framboise Lambic 12oz./\$6.50

The acidity of Lambic beers blends perfectly with raspberries. Magnificent aroma, delicate palate of raspberries with undertones of fruity acidity; elegant, sparkling clean natural taste. **5% abv.**

Belgium

Chimay Red 11.2 oz./\$10.50

It is noted for its coppery color which makes it particularly attractive. Topped with a creamy head, gives off a light, fruity apricot aroma produced by the fermentation. The taste perceived in the mouth is a balance confirming the fruity nuances noticed in the fragrance. **8% abv.**

Chimay Triple 11.2oz./\$12

This beer is noted for its golden color, its slightly hazy appearance and its fine head is especially characterized by its aroma which results from an agreeable combination of fresh hops and yeast. **8% abv.**

Chimay Blue 11.2oz./\$12.50

It is principally distinguished by its character of a strong beer. This is a beer whose fragrance of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch is especially pleasant. Its flavour, notices when tasting it, only accentuates the pleasant sensations perceived in the aroma, while revealing a light but pleasant touch of roasted malt. **8% abv.**

Westmalle Tripel 11.2oz/\$6.50

A clear, golden yellow Trappist beer that undergoes a secondary fermentation in the bottle. It is a complex beer with a fruity aroma and a nice nuanced hop scent. It is soft and creamy in the mouth, with a bitter touch carried by the fruity aroma. **9.5% abv.**

Westmalle Dubbel 11.2oz/\$6.50

A dark, reddish-brown Trappist beer. The creamy head has the fragrance of special malt and leaves an attractive lace pattern in the glass. The flavor is rich and complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish. It is a balanced quality beer with a soft feel in the mouth and a long, dry aftertaste. **7% abv.**

Affligem Blonde 11.2oz/\$6.50

A classic ale with a deep golden colour and a full body. It is well balanced, with a sweetish, refreshing fruity flavour and a hoppy, dry finish. **6% abv.**

De Koninck 12oz/\$6.50

Amber colored, top-fermented beer with a lively taste and velvet soft aroma. Brewed with Saaz hops and malt 100% pure, without the addition of maize or other brewers' sugars. **5% abv**

Trappist Achel Bruin 11.2oz/\$14

This dark amber, flavorful beer is surprisingly refreshing by volume. It is lightly filtered, but still wholesomely hazy with yeast remaining in the bottle. **8.0% abv.**

Trappist Achel Blonde 11.2oz/\$14

This blond, flavorful beer is a surprisingly refreshing brew. It is lightly filtered, but still wholesomely hazy with yeast remaining in the bottle. **8.0% abv.**

Germany

EKU 28 12oz/\$7.50

Robust malt with a strong caramel liqueur flavor. A slight hop bitterness and a grassy component as well. This is a fabled after-dinner digestif, a splendid winter warmer, or a soothing nightcap in any season. **11.0% abv.**

Paulaner Hefe-Weizen 12oz/\$5.50

It is a classic Bavarian wheat beer. "Hefe" in German translates to yeast and "Weizen" (pronounced Vi-Zen) translates to wheat. Yeast retained in the beer is responsible for the cloudy appearance. Contains 60% malted wheat and 40% malted barley. **5.5% abv.**

England

New Castle Brown Ale 12oz/\$5.50

Is a amber toned brown with a small white head that quickly fades into a mild cap and collar. Smell is of toasted nuts, sweet biscuits, mild caramel, and freshly baked bread. Taste is of the aromas with a mild bit of freshly cracked grain and a hint of sweet fruit with a banana peel flavor coming out. **4.7% abv.**

Japan

Kirin 12oz/\$6.50

The luxurious single wort process yields a unique, complex flavor. Ichiban outclasses and outperforms. But don't be fooled by a snooty attitude -- this is a great beer that goes with anything. **5% abv.**

America

Pretty Things Jack D'Or (Massachusetts) 1 pint/\$25

This is a simple table beer, or "Saison Americain" as we are referring to it. Its an American take on the Belgian saison style. **6.4% abv.**

Stone IPA (San Diego) 12oz./\$5.50

With a deep golden color, an "India Pale Ale" by definition is highly hopped and high in alcohol. This medium bodied, refreshing ale displays light-medium malt character. **6.9% abv.**

Jolly Pumpkin La Roja (Michigan) 1pint/\$25

An artisan amber ale brewed in the Flanders tradition. Deep amber with earthy caramel, spice, and sour fruit notes developed through natural barrel aging. Unfiltered, unpasteurized and blended from barrels ranging in age from two to ten months. **7.2% abv.**

Peak Organic IPA (Maine) 12oz./\$5.50

A beautifully crafted IPA that uses all Organic malts and hops! Big citrus notes throughout from the high amount of hops with a clean, crisp, yet light, malt backbone. **7.2% abv.**

Peak Organic Espresso Amber Al (Maine) 12oz./\$5.50

A robust amber ale with a huge, roasty, espresso note. This is for all the coffee lovers out there. Made with "Fair Trade Organic" coffees! This is the quintessential dessert beer. **7% abv.**

Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA (Delaware) 12 oz./\$6

This beer is continuously hopped - more than 60 hop additions over a 60 minute boil. A powerful, but balanced East Coast I.P.A. with a lot of citrusy hop character. **6% abv.**

Dogfish Head Raison D'Etre (Delaware) 12oz./\$6

A deep, mahogany ale brewed with beet sugar, green raisins, and Belgian-style yeast. As complex as a fine, red wine. **8% abv.**

Wild Blue (New York) 12oz/\$7

Pours purple/red with a pinkish-purplish-whitish head. Great as a dessert beer! Very sweet, robust flavor! **8% abv.**

Blue Point Toasted Lager (New York) 12oz./\$5.50

Copper in color, this unique Lager has a complex character with hints of caramel malts and hops. **5.2% abv.**

Goose Island Matilda (Chicago) 650ml/\$17.50

Wild in character, with a slightly fruity aroma and a spicy yeast flavor that is as unique as it is satisfying - Matilda is an intriguing choice for beer and wine lovers alike. **7% abv.**

Goose Island Pere Jacques (Chicago) 650ml/\$7.50

Brewed with loads of malt and Belgian yeast, Pere Jacques is a wonderfully fruity, malty ale. Pere Jacques' complex flavors stand shoulder to shoulder with the Belgian Dubbels. **8% abv.**

Ithaca "Flower Power" IPA (New York) 12 oz./\$6.00

A big IPA for the Hopheads out there! This is made with 5 different Northwest American hops that give off big floral and citrus notes. It is also unfiltered which makes it easier drinking! **8% abv.**

Spain

Estrella Damm "Inedit" 750 ml./\$24

It is made with Barley and Wheat malts and spiced with coriander, orange peel and liquorice. Soft mouth feel and nice carbonation lend to the creaminess of this very unique beer. **4.8% abv.**

Italy

ReAle Extra 1 pint/\$32

Amber colour with a small creamy foam. In the nose hoppy notes explode. Grapefruit, bitter orange, manadarin, resinous and spicy notes are perfectly married with caramel and honey notes coming from the malts. **6.9% abv.**

Tapetto Volante 12oz/\$5.50

Light and crisp with a touch of sweetness. Pure mountain water and choice ingredients combine with brewing heritage and tradition to create Tapetto Volante. **5.0% abv.**
